Changes to the start date of the school year...

Dear Holy Spirit Families,

We are looking forward to the start of the new school year and the return of students to the Holy Spirit School campus!

As you might imagine, with the continuous flow of new information, procedures, and guidance surrounding COVID-19, we spend our days assessing and reassessing our reopening plans while also trying to complete the routine items of a "regular" school opening. It seems as though, to mix my metaphors, the goal posts are constantly being changed and each hurdle gets a bit higher. The most recent developments have come in the form of the Emergency Temporary Standard Infection Disease Prevention: SARS-CoV-2 Virus that Causes COVID-19 as put into effect by the Virginia Department of Labor. These Standards are geared to labor standards for employees, but certainly throw yet another wrinkle into how we approach the year. Additionally, we struggle to receive materials and supplies from taxed vendors as so many schools and places of business are looking for similar items.

Students should bring the masks and face shield on their orientation day in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with the student's name.


Each day students should come to school with a clean mask already on in order to enter the school building!

The YEARBOOKS FINALLY! For families who ordered a yearbook, they will be delivered to your student(s) during orientation.




