Can't wait for tomorrow!

Everyone on the faculty and staff is super excited to see everyone tomorrow, Friday, August 23rd for the Open House from 1:00 - 2:30 pm. We hope you are excited too!

During the Open House families should be sure to stop at the tables in the front lobby to pick up your family packet. IT IS STUFFED FULL! The most important pieces in the packet are the forms that should be returned on Monday like the Emergency Care form, handbook signature pages, family demographics, etc. Included also in the packet though are a plethora of hard copies of various flyers announcing both school and parish events. Please be sure to take a look at everything.

If you cannot attend the Open House - NO WORRIES! Your family packet will be sent home with your youngest or only child on their first day of school.

Please keep in mind that the car lines both in the morning and afternoon can be a bit longer while everyone gets back in the swing of things. I would ask that you be patient as there are many new families with us learning the ins and outs of the school's routine. To mix things up just a bit - we will also be handling a 10:00 am funeral that morning and a reception for said funeral directly following in the school. It will be super important that everyone is really following the direction of the staff who will be in the parking lots to manage the traffic the very best that we can. There will be a second funeral reception at the school on Tuesday that may impact the afternoon car lines as well.

I would like to draw your attention to a few calendar items that will sneak right up

First, Back to School Nights are scheduled for Tuesday, September 3rd (grades 1-5) and Wednesday, September 4th (grades 6-8). Please make note of the start time of each of these evenings - it is **6:30 pm.** Parents of children in prekindergarten and kindergarten are encouraged to attend the opening part of the evening to hear all of the general information regarding the coming year and the presentation from the PTO officers.

Second, on Monday, September 9th we will celebrate the Virgin Mary's birthday with a prayer service at 8:30 am. We are asking that each child bring in one to two flowers that morning to contribute to a class flower arrangement for the procession.

Third, please note on your calendars that Monday, September 23rd will be an early release day with an odd time - we will release at 12:00 noon that day (information regarding exact bell times will be forthcoming; Extended Day will be open). As some of you may recall our school visit from Bishop Burbidge was cancelled last year due to inclement weather and it has been rescheduled for September 23rd.

Fourth, Holy Spirit Parish and School have the honor to host the Diocesan Mass for Disabilities on Sunday, September 29th at the 10:30 am Mass. I would encourage all of our families to attend this Mass which is said by Bishop Burbidge to celebrate the unique gifts of all. Many of our own students will be participating directly in the Mass from readers, to gift bearers, to choir members. There will be a reception following the Mass in the school.

Child Protection Compliance

With regard to Child Protection Compliance, I cannot stress enough the importance of parents and guardians being compliant. Without having participated in both the background check process and the Virtus seminar you cannot volunteer for school functions where the children are present.

NOTE: THIS ALSO INCLUDES RECESS DUTY AS WE NO LONGER HAVE ANY TYPE OF WAIVER FOR THIS.

If you have not completed the requirements to be Child Protection Compliant, I highly encourage you to begin now. Check the school website under the *Current Families Resources* tab for the pertinent information as the Diocese rolled out a new procedure for volunteers this Summer.






