We are getting close to our Christmas break with still some very important events to come:



Dear Friends,

The Advent season is upon us as we have officially begun our journey of anticipation and expectation for our Savior, Jesus. It is truly a joyous time.

I am thankful for the opportunity to count you as my Holy Spirit family. I am also thankful for a different kind of journey. One that others in our Holy Spirit family may have gone through or are currently going through. A journey that none asked for, but one that I embrace none-the-less.

Seven years ago, I was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's follicular lymphoma, a blood

cancer. This is the first time that I have needed treatment. Our Lord has a plan for even this. My chemotherapy begins December 16th-20th, with approximately bimonthly treatments until June. My doctor anticipates that I will continue working with minimal disruption to my science responsibilities.

Facts:

- This type of cancer is a manageable blood cancer very treatable, not curable
- The treatment in known and very effective

Communication with my children:

• My wife Laura and I have been upfront with our children regarding my situation and we have let them know that after each dosage, I might even feel sick and tired. Please don't get overly concerned with them - it may cause them to become overly worried;)


My goals through this are:

2nd Grade- "Townspeople"


The 2nd graders will wear long sleeve light brown shirts and black pants, black socks and brown shoes. They will be provided with head scarves to keep them looking Biblical.


