All of the new ActivPanels have been installed in the classrooms. We are putting final touches (some rooms needed audio installed and all panels need the ActivConnect activated) and teachers have already begun to use the panels in their rooms. It is lovely to walk by a classroom that has the lights on, the shades up, and the ActivPanel on with full visibility!

We continue to need to raise funds to pay for the panels. As was relayed at the outset, the cost of the panels alone is \$140,000.00. 


