Driving in and around Holy Spirit

Throughout our 50+ years, the Holy Spirit School community has always striven to be a good neighbor to those who live in and around the campus. With that in mind, I was quite concerned when I received a phone call yesterday from someone who lives on Woodland Way who told me that she had literally almost been run over by one of our families as she walked across Woodland Way and onto the campus. This incident was also reported to me by one of our school families who witnessed the event.

Everyone has places to be but the safety of pedestrians (we also have students who walk to and from school) should be paramount for everyone as you drive along Woodland Way and while driving on the school campus.

With that in mind, I realize that Wednesday was an anomaly in that no one was in the lower parking lot and the gate from Braddock Road was not closed during arrival due to a "perfect storm" of events leading to things within the school building needing to be taken of prior to the start of the day. Regardless of whether the Braddock Road gate is open during arrival or dismissal times, please only enter the campus from Woodland Way and please follow the traffic pattern that has been in place for several years now.

We have had several minor car accidents on the campus this year - really there should be none if everyone remembers to slow down and follow the procedures that are in place for arrival and dismissal.

Yesterday the students participated in a couple of assemblies with Mr. Peace, Kevin Szawala.






