## Safety always...

If you would please indulge me by being mindful of a couple of items that are important to student safety here at Holy Spirit and that are specific to arrival and dismissal particularly in the front of the school. With regard to drop-off and pick-up, please remember that students should only be exiting and entering the car through doors that are on the passenger side of the car. There are often cars that are not driven by our school families that are exiting the campus and do not follow our carline procedures. Also, as much as our terrific Safety Patrol students would like to help all students exiting cars, please note that they are explicitly instructed to NOT step past the yellow curb and down into the road. So, if they do not open the car door for your student they are not being rude they are simply following the safety requirements that we have in place for them. 


