
June 2nd - be there!

Mass Resumes Friday, May 29, 2020

Dispensation

All the faithful of the Diocese of Arlington continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation until further notice.

Public Worship Resumes

Congregation size is strictly limited to a maximum of up to 50% seating capacity with social distancing of at least six feet. (Families and members of the same household are exempt from these six-foot social distancing requirements.)

Mass Schedule

The normal schedule for both weekday and Sunday Masses will commence effective May 29.

Registration Required

To secure seating to attend Sunday Masses (to include the Vigil Mass), pre-registration is required. Either go to the parish website to reserve seating or contact the parish office (703-978-8074) for assistance.

Health & Safety Protocols

It is expected that those attending will wear a face mask. Please bring your own.
It is also expeced that those attending will disinfect their hands before entering the church and again immediately before receiving Communion.

Caution

There remains an inherent risk in coming to church at this time. If you or those for whom you care are vulnerable to infection, Bishop Burbidge encourages you to stay home. If you feel sick in any way, do not come.
