I hope that you are all able to clear your schedules for Friday, October 26th and can join us for an evening of fun, fun, fun!

One of our favorite week's of the year is almost here - Spirit Week! Please be sure to look at the information below so that your children can participate to the fullest. Concurrent with Spirit Week will be our annual Ton of Love food drive to benefit the Catholic Charities St. Lucy Project and the always spirited Turkey Shoot Out.

If you can volunteer in some of the P.E. classes ahead of the final Turkey Shoot competition the link is below. All proceeds from the Turkey Shoot go to the St. Lucy Project along with all of the non-perishable food items we collect. "Blue bags" for the food collection will be coming home next week.

A reminder that 1st Trimester interims will go home tomorrow, Friday, October 12th. Parents in grades 3-8 are encouraged to regularly check the parent portal to

keep abreast of your children's successes. Paper interims will go home only for those children who currently have a 75% or lower in a core academic subject or an "X" or a "1" in a Special.

Additionally, for all children in grades 3-8 the Scantron testing results from the Fall testing session will be going home tomorrow. If you have questions about the results, I encourage you to reach out to your child's teacher.

Despite the 1st Trimester not ending until November 30th, parent/teacher conferences are scheduled for November 9 and November 12. Please be on the look out for the Sign-Up Genius to schedule your conferences in the next couple of weeks.

Friday, November 9th will be a half day for students and Extended Day will be open while conferences take place that afternoon. In the morning of the 9th we will have a special flag raising and ceremony in honor of Veterans Day. Information coming soon!

Monday, November 12th is a NO school day for all students while parent/teacher conferences take place.

A reminder that yearbook picture retakes will be Wednesday, November 7th. For those who purchased them, you should have already received your child's picture packet.

The 8th grade students will receive the sacrament of Confirmation on Monday, November 19th at 7:00 pm. The 8th grade students have been "gifted" a day-off on Tuesday, November 20th.

The Thanksgiving break for the whole school is Wednesday, November 21 through Sunday, November 26th.

Formation in Christian Chastity

The Diocesan developed "Formation in Christian Chastity" program is taught to all children in grades 1-8 in all Diocesan schools and in parish religious education programs.

At Holy Spirit School, this curriculum is taught in the regular religion classes during one week in the Fall. This year the information will be taught during the week of October 15th.

This is an "opt-out" program meaning that parents must sign and return the waiver in order for students to be excused from the program and the waiver must be received by Friday, October 12th.

DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM Office of Catholic Schools Academic Year 2019-2020

What is the program?

The Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program provides financial assistance to families in Catholic schools in the Diocese of Arlington through funding from diocesan parishes as well as the Rooted in Faith~Forward in Hope Capital Campaign Endowment. It is open to all qualified students whose parents might not otherwise be able to pay the full cost of tuition.

Who is eligible?

- Students attending or accepted by a Diocese of Arlington Catholic school (K-12).
 - · Preschool and Pre-K are not eligible.
 - Not applicable to students of private Catholic schools associated with the Diocese and/or international students.
- Students who are Catholic and members of a parish in the Diocese of Arlington or military base parish.
- Families who reside within the boundaries of the Diocese of Arlington and are registered and active members of a diocesan parish or a military base parish.

How do I apply?

- Submit financial aid assessment application and all supporting tax documentation by due date
 - Applications will be completed electronically online at <u>online.factsmgt.com/Signin</u>
 - Only one application is required per family.
- Remit processing fee.
- Families seeking aid for students in BOTH ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL should follow the high school submission date.

Due Dates: HIGH SCHOOL January 22, 2019

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL March 15, 2019

Awards

Awards are made for **ONE ACADEMIC YEAR** and are based on each family's demonstrated financial need. Individual schools determine the amount and the distribution of all awards for each academic year. The schools will contact families when award decisions have been made. Once these final award decisions have been made, the schools will then credit the tuition accounts of approved families.




