
Next Thursday, September 21st we will have our annual Pinwheels for Peace prayer service beginning at 8:25 am in the gymnasium. All are welcome to join us.

Fall Yearbook pictures will be taken on Tuesday, September 26th - this would be a great time for haircuts for those still sporting their "summer look". Those families whose "Photo Release" form was in question should have received an additional copy. If you would like to amend your form, please take a moment to fill out that form and return it as soon as possible.

One of the tasks that we have at the start of the school year is to run through many of the emergency drills we have in place. Each week through the month of September we have a fire drill. Additionally, in the month of September we go through the two lockdown drills for the school. The drill regarding an intruder on campus (outside of the building) was held earlier in the week. During this drill instruction continues for the student as usual so their is little disruption to their day. Next week, in the latter half of the week, we will have

the lockdown drill for an intruder in the building. This drill can be a bit more unsettling for students as we lock doors, darken classrooms, and move students, as much as possible, out of the line of any windows. Although as adults we can rationalize this particular drill and understand the importance of it, the situation can be difficult for students up and down the line from prekindergarten to 8th grade. On the day that the drill takes place, I will send a notification to parents letting you know so that if your student comes home and wants to talk about it you are prepared for that. As we move through the next several months we will also drill for earthquakes and tornadoes, as well as keeping up with our monthly fire drills.

On October 4th at 7:00pm the PTO will sponsor a special screening of the film *Screenagers*. The 68 minute film takes a look at the impact of the digital age on children. Physician and filmmaker Delaney Ruston saw what was happening with her own kids and began a quest to uncover how it might impact their development. Without passing judgement, the film looks at negative impacts of screen time and offers insights to finding balance. The film is appropriate for both parents and children (my suggestion would be children 5th grade and up, although if you've made the decision to allow your younger child to have a cellphone or to have regular access to video games or computer time this may offer great information for them too). Individuals or families do need to register prior to the viewing.



Are You Child Protection Compliant?

The Diocese of Arlington requires that all adults be fully compliant with its Child Protection Policies. It is all about being proactive to protect our children and keep them safe from sexual predators.

Compliancy includes:

- 1. Completion of Background Paperwork Packet available from Holy Spirit's Child Protection Office
 - o one document requires notarization Lambie Renner, our Child Protection Coordinator, is
 a notary and can provide that service free of charge (Hannah Steger, in the Child Protection
 Office, and Anson Groves, in the RE office, are also notaries and will do the same)
- Attendance at a Virtus Seminar (<u>www.virtus.org</u> click on Registration on the left panel then click on View a List of Sessions, asking for the Arlington Diocese.)
 We are offering two at our very own parish! Thursday, September 14 will be 6:30PM-10:30PM and Saturday, October 7 will be 9:00AM-1:00PM. Hurry and sign up before all the spots fill up!

What if I am already compliant?

If you were compliant at another diocesan parish, we can have your records transferred to our parish. Simply send an email to Lambie Renner or Hannah Steger childprotection@holyspiritchurch.us stating the parish you came from and asking that your records be changed to Holy Spirit. The official diocesan policy is that you may not volunteer until you are fully compliant in the database.

How long does this last?

Once you are compliant (both the background paperwork completed and attendance at a Virtus seminar) you are always compliant. If you remain on our parish active list, your background check will be re-done every 5 years automatically.

How do I get a Background Paperwork Packet?

A background paperwork packet can be picked up from the school office. However, if you would like a Background Paperwork Packet sent home with your child, send an email to Lisa Laclede (llaclede@holyspiritflames.org) and give your child's name, grade, and teacher. If you are able to bring the packet back in person, that is preferred however, if you have it notarized and have completed your contact information on the form on the outside of the envelope, you may send it back with your child.

Please feel free to contact Lambie Renner or Hannah Steger in the Child Protection Office if you have any questions. The Child Protection Office is with the Youth Office in the school building.


