Here we go!

Wow! Where have the weeks of Summer gone?

It is hard to believe in just a few short weeks we will launch our 2021/2022 school year. I pray you are enjoying the time away from school and that you and your children are ready to embrace the new school year and all of the excitement that it holds. We welcome back our returning Holy Spirit families and all those who are new to our community – we look forward to getting to know everyone.

The faculty has chosen the theme of "In work there is dignity" as we highlight throughout the year the Catholic Social Teaching of the dignity of work and the rights of workers. We look forward to continuing to provide opportunities for the students both in and out of classrooms to live the Catholic Faith.

We have a couple of new teaching/homeroom assignments for the year. Mrs. Taylor Webb will move to the Resource Department as she completes her Master in Special Education. Mr. Greg Gordon will have teaching responsibilities including 7th grade Religion and 6th grade Language Arts. Mrs. Rebekah (Solee) Tucker will be a 6th grade homeroom teacher and will take over the Social Studies classes for the Middle School. Mrs. Rita Callahan, who was a proctor for us last year, will now be a full-time aide in one of the kindergarten classrooms and Mrs. Sara O'Brien who was also a proctor last year

will now be a paraeducator in the Resource Department.

We also have new faculty and staff members with us this year. We welcome back two teachers who were here at Holy Spirit year ago: Mrs. Molly Guthrie will be the lead teacher in one of the prekindergarten classrooms and Mrs. Patty Case will be a part of the 3rd grade team. Ms. Isabel Kazan joins the Middle School as a 6^{h} grade homeroom teacher and will be responsible for the 6^{th} grade Religion and 8^{th} grade Language Arts curriculums; Mrs. Eve Montavon joins us as the School Counselor; Mrs. Patti Zamiska will join the prekindergarten team as a classroom aide

If, by chance, your student has not completed his/her summer work, now would be great time to be sure students are on track to have everything finished as most everything is due either the first day or first week of school.

If you have a rising kindergartener or are a new family to the school, all required medical forms must be returned as soon as possible. School law prohibits school attendance without the required documentation. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Wild.

If you are interested in either Morning Care or Extended Day, the registration document is available on the website, you may send that in now and you will be billed the registration fee via FACTS.

On August 18th at 6:00 pm the NEW family ice cream social sponsored by the PTO will be held on the lawn out in front of the school. We invite all new families (parents and children) to join us.

On August 20th there will be an opportunity to meet the teachers, find out homeroom assignments and take a peek at the classrooms. This year we are splitting up the arrival times in order to give students a bit more time to really see their teacher. Families with last names from A-M are invited to come by the school between 11:00 am – 12:00 pm. Families with last names from N-Z are invited between 1:00-2:00 pm. We look forward to seeing all of you then and ask that you please not come to school for an extra early sneak peek prior during the week of August 16th as the teachers and administrators will be very busy with meetings and classroom set-up.

Paperwork needed for the start of the school year will be available for pickup during the August 20th Open House in order to give families the weekend to fill out the many required forms. Please return all forms on Monday, August 23rd.

For **Grades 1-8** Monday, August 23rd is an 11:30 am dismissal; the rest of the week are full days. No School lunches will be provided the first week of school. Please pack a lunch for your child the first week.

School for **Grades 1-8** begins on August 23rd at 8:00 am. Please make every effort to begin the good habit of arriving on time. Drop off begins at 7:40 am; I will see you in the parking lot! Teachers will meet the students outside and escort them to their classrooms. Parents are asked to say their goodbyes as they drop their children off in the carline. (If you want to park and watch from the upper lot after you drop off your children you are welcome to.) Please refer to the handbook that will be posted on the webpage for complete directions on arrival and pickup procedures. During the first week of school the vanpool slots for last year will be used with the EXCEPTION of kindergarteners who are now first graders. These students will be dismissed with the regular carpool unless they are in a group vanpool that used a non-kindergarten slot. Applications for vanpool slots will be sent home in the beginning of the year packet.

A **kindergarten parent meeting** (no students) is scheduled for Monday, August 23rd at 8:30 am. Kindergartners' first day will be Tuesday, August 24th, from 8:00 – 11:30 am

(with no afternoon Extended Day for them this first day). The remainder of the week is full days.

The **prekindergarten parent meeting** (no students) is at 9:30 am on Monday, August 23^{rd} . The prekindergarten orientation for the students and parents is on Tuesday, August 24^{th} . Students with last names beginning A through L are asked to come from 9:00 - 9:45 am and students with last names beginning with M through Z are asked to come from 10:00 - 10:45 am. Classes begin for prekindergarten on Wednesday, August 29^{th} ; this is a half day for all PreK students with dismissal at 11:30am (there is no afternoon Extended Day for PreK this first day). Thursday and Friday are full days.

Morning Care will be open at 7:00 am on the first day of school. Morning care is located in the cafeteria. Families should park in the rear of the building and access the cafeteria via the back doors. Grade levels may begin using Morning Care on the following dates:

Grades 1-8 – may begin using Morning Care on Monday, August 23rd Kindergarten – may begin using Morning Care on Tuesday, August 24th PreKindergarten – may begin using Morning Care on Wednesday, August 25th

Afternoon Extended Care for all grades will begin in the cafeteria. Grade levels may begin using Afternoon Extended Care on the following dates:

Grades 1-8 – may begin using Extended Day on Monday, August 23rd Kindergarten – may begin using Extended Day on Wednesday, August 25th PreKindergarten – may begin using Extended Day on Thursday, August 26th Afternoon Extended Day is closed completely on Friday, September 3rd due to the early dismissal prior to the Labor Day weekend.
