### Here we go, again!

As I sit here composing this email, the hallways are quiet but the classrooms are brimming with smiles and learning. I think coming back after an extended break is tiring for everyone as we edge towards the end of the week!

Thank you to everyone for being so forthright with information about your holiday travels and for continuing to error on the side of caution when making determinations about sending your children into school.

The 2nd Trimester is quickly moving to the half-way point! Now would be a great time to assess the supplies that your student should have for class and make sure things like paper, pencils and pens are still plentiful.

The second testing session for Scantron (grade 3-7) begins next week. Although these are not necessarily what would be considered "high stakes" tests, it would be helpful to remind your children that they want to put forth their best effort. The format for the assessment has changed this year; students are still assessed in three areas: mathematics, reading, English grammar, but they are challenged with only 25 questions for each area. Although there is a definitive number of questions, the assessment is still "adaptive" in that students are provided questions based on where they scored in the last session and whether they are correctly or incorrectly completing questions. It is important to note that it is not possible for students to go back to questions and redo them; once they have chosen an answer the assessment moves forward. Thank you for your support!

This year due to the current restrictions in place regarding field trips, we will not be taking interested 8th graders to the Life is VERY Good event or the March for Life on January 29th.

We will have Mass here at school for the older students just as we always do on Fridays. We will pray the rosary as a whole school, as well.

It is my understanding that the parish will not be providing buses this year; please check the parish bulletin for the schedule of events for the day here at the parish.

Catholic Schools Week, the week where we get to celebrate along with others all that is great about our school, is right around the corner! Please look for information in the next week or so for the schedule of events.

If you are looking to apply for tuition assistance for the 2021/2022 academic year, you must complete a FACTS application. Information regarding tuition assistance is available on the school website under the *Current Families Resources* tab. The deadline for applying is March 17, 2021.

For our current families who have younger siblings who will be ready for school next year, now is the time to let us know! We have begun accepting preschool and kindergarten students for the 2021/2022 academic year. If you have a child who is ready for school, you must complete an application for your child and pay the application fee.
