



Registering for Connect 1 at Holy Spirit School

How to sign up for an account on Connect1:

- 1. On your computer, go to https://app.connect1.io
- 2. Click the green bar that says "Sign up (School Code).



- Enter your email address. Enter our school code, which is I41VP6.
 (Are you both a teacher and a parent at the school? You'll need to set up two accounts. One using your "holyspirit flames.org" email account for you role as a teacher, and your personal one for your role as a parent!)
- 4. This will open a new page where you enter your name, role and password. For Role, select "Parent/Community Member". (Unless you are a teacher creating your account with your "holyspiritflames.org" account. In that case, please select "Faculty/School Employee".) Click Submit when you are done.
- Anew page opens. AConfirmation Code will be sent to your email. Copy that confirmation code and paste it into this page. Click Confirm.
- This brings you back to the Sign In page. Enter your email address and newly created password to open the app.


