The students will learn that this cermony honors "both the symbol of our nation and our fellow citizens who rallied to it, fought for it, and died defending it." Helping our students to grow up to be productive and proud citizens of the United States is another important part of the history of Catholic education in this country. Parents are invited and the ceremony will begin at 9:00 am.

Please thank them from everyone here at St. Lucy's and let them know how wonderful they are for their charitable donations.





are responsible for signing themselves up for a timeslot.





Second, prayerfully form your conscience. We recommend reading the VCC's Four Principles of Catholic Social Teaching bulletin insert.

As we have stated in previous pre-election letters, three foundational principles are essential to consci-formation as it relates to assessing candidates and their positions:

Above all, we are called to pursue "the preeminent requirement to protect the weakest in our midst-innocent unborn children — by restricting and bringing to an end the destruction of unborn children through abortion and providing women in crisis pregnancies the supports they need to make a decis life" (United States Conference of Catholic Bisbops, Forming Conscience, for Faithful Citizenship.

Earlier this year, the U.S. Supreme Court's *Dobbs* decision restored to the people and their elected representatives the power to safeguard life from the moment of conception. Through prayer and act with our voices and our votes, it is our responsibility as faithful citizens to exercise our power to pre the lives of the powerless.
