Just a couple of safety reminders

As we have settled into the year and are quickly making our way into the heart of the month of October, I would like to just send out a couple of reminders.

Please be sure that when you are approaching the school on Woodland Way and traversing the campus you are cognizant of your speed. We have several children who walk to and from school (as well as neighbors catching the Metro bus) and they must cross Woodland Way to get to school, please be on the lookout for them. Additionally, once you enter the campus be certain to lower your speed in order to be on the lookout for students, faculty, staff and parishioners who may be on foot.

Regardless of whether there is a line of cars or not, please follow the usual traffic pattern, it doesn't take but one quick turn of the traffic light for the line to grow once again and if a car is angled incorrectly it can cause issues with the subsequent lines.

Lastly, please refrain from being on you cell phone when your car is moving. Thank you!

As we stack our days together, it may be easy to get lulled into a false sense of security, but we continue to ask families to be cognizant of your travels and the sphere of your interactions

 automatically sends a gift receipt to Catholic Charities with all the
 information they need to give our organization credit for the food
 donation.
- IF there is more than one food item selected, each item will need "HS Flames" inserted into the "Gift Message" text box and a gift receipt email of St.Lucy@ccda.net (this is because orders can be shipped in multiple boxes and come from multiple distribution centers).
- The donor's name will automatically be included.

All donations will be shipped and received at St. Lucy's Manassas Warehouse. Catholic Charities will unpack each box and collect the gift receipt packing slips. They will also receive the digital email from Amazon confirming the donor's name and items donated.


