Entering his 10th season at the helm of the Paul VI Boys Soccer Program, Leiva has enjoyed tremendous success in Fairfax. Under Leiva, the Panthers have established themselves as one of the elite high school programs in the DC Metro, winning over 90 games including the 2010 and 2015 VISAA state titles. Known for turning programs around, Leiva took his 1992 Real Mclean boys club team from obscurity to the 1st Division of the NCSL and winners of the Nat'l Indoor Championship. A select group of PVI players won the 2013 edition of the same Nat'l Indoor Championship Tourney. During his career, Leiva has helped over 60 players move on to play at the collegiate level. Matt has coached numerous players to WCAC, Washington Post All-Met and VISAA state honors, including the 2012, 2014 and 2015 VISAA players of the year.
