The purpose of the National League of Junior Cotillions program is to give young people instruction in etiquette, manners, and character education; to give them training in standard ballroom dance; and to provide opportunities to practice and enjoy these skills. The program helps students to develop the confidence and poise that comes from knowing the proper etiquette for any social situation.

We offer programs for students in sixth grade through high school. Each program is developed to meet the needs of the students in that particular age group. New students in all grades are welcome to join us, and need not have participated previously.

### The first two years of Junior Cotillion are for students in grades 6 & 7.

The Chantilly Chapter, which meets at the International Country Club in Chantilly

(13200 Lee Jackson Memorial Highway), on Wednesday evenings.

The Oakton-Tysons (Vienna) Chapter, which meets at the American Legion Patriot Hall (330 N. Center Street) in Vienna, on Monday evenings.

The Reston Chapter, which meets at the Hidden Creek Country Club (1711 Clubhouse Road) in Reston, on Tuesday evenings. The Springfield Chapter, which meets at the Springfield Country Club (8301 Old Keene Mill Road) in Springfield, on Thursday evenings.

#### The Eighth Grade Program

This program features a Fall Social with a casual dining experience, an evening at the Theatre, a Grand Ball with a Continental service dinner, and three classes. The Fall Social and the Grand Ball will be held at Springfield Country Club. (Location for the Theatre Event is yet to be determined.) The group is split for the classes.
