I know that the Carpool line has been a challenge this week. It does get better!

A couple of reminders:

During morning drop-off, no students should be dropped off in the upper parking lot and allowed to walk down the sidewalk to the front of the school. I know everyone is busy and has somewhere to be but for the safety of everyone involved all cars should come through the front car line. (This excludes PreKindergarten families who drop-off in the rear of the school.)

The drop-off line moves much faster if students are ready to go when you reach the sidewalk. Parents should stay in the car and allow teachers to assist the students. All students must exit on the right side of the car so that they step immediately onto the sidewalk. Regardless of where you child's class lines-up, please have your child get out of the car at the first spot at which you stop along the sidewalk; do not make multiple drop-offs or stops.

In the afternoon, please be sure that you are filling in one line at a time and I ask that you be cognizant of not cutting into a line in front of others.

Parents may not park in the upper lot and walk down to retrieve students from the front of the school. Again, I understand that many are in a hurry and have places to be but for safety and out of fairness all should wait in the carpool line.

As after school activities begin and more children begin attending Extended Day, the carpool line will return to its usual 10-15 minute "event".

Vanpool

The new vanpool slots (cars picking up three or more students) will be sent home on Friday. The new slots should be used beginning Tuesday, September 7th. (Current Kindergarten families already have their numbers and should be using the slots.)

Please remember that you must be in the lot by 3:05 pm before the chains are put up. If you arrive after the chains have been put up you must circle down to the carpool line and your students will be walked down there. You may not park and walk across the chains/past the cones to retrieve students.
