Thursday, April 2nd (Holy Thursday) will now be a full day of school; no afternoon extended day.

The last day for grades 1-8 is Tuesday, June 16th and this is a full day of school; no afternoon extended day.

Hopefully each family with students in grades 3-8 has been able to sign-in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal. If you encounter any problems, please contact Mrs. Laclede. This is a wonderful tool for students and parents to help keep track of assignments and grades. The teachers will be keeping their gradebooks up to date but please keep in mind that tests and projects take longer to grade.

I give a huge amount of credit to each of these students who spent much time and effort completing their independent project and for the wonderful job that each did in defending their work to the fair judges.

As you make appointments in the coming months, please keep in mind that the week of April 20th will be Terra Nova standardized testing for grades 3-7. The 5th and 8th graders will complete the ACRE standardized test as well. The Office of Catholic Schools has made the decision to no longer require standardized testing for the students in the second grade. The decision is based on studies and information which questions the validity of standardized tests being administered to such a young age group. Additionally, it is felt that the current math and language arts programs have comprehensive assessment pieces embedded into them which give teachers sufficient information for instructional alignment.

Congratulations to those students in the 8th grade class who applied and were accepted to the four Diocesan high schools. Holy Spirit students posted a 100% acceptance rate to the Diocesan schools. I am very proud of their accomplishment and congratulate as well the families and teachers for this wonderful achievement.
