## We are excited to see you at Open House!

#### **Dear Holy Spirit Families:**

We've arrived! The 2017/2018 school year is here and we cannot wait to see all of our students and families tomorrow, Friday, August 25th from 1:00 - 2:30pm at the Open House. The faculty has had a busy, busy week of learning and preparing and are excited to greet their students.

Over the past couple of weeks we have rounded out our teaching faculty and I am thrilled to have these educators with us for the year. Mrs. Fairis Walker is joining the Resource team as a paraeducator; Mrs. Andrea Fitch will be with the students in grade 1-4 as their Spanish instructor; and Mrs. Isabel Liss is bringing her creativity and beautiful skills to the position of Art Instructor for the year.

A reminder that when you come to the Open House be sure to collect TWO packets of information for your family. One packet will have all of the forms that are needed by the school such as emergency contact information, photo releases, lunch menus, etc. The second packet will be from the PTO Auction Committee.

A gentle reminder to please be prepared for lengthy carlines the first week of school. Morning drop-off begins at 7:40 am - please be sure to follow instructions from myself and others who will be stationed in the lower parking lot as we work to get everyone safely into the school. All of the teachers will be outside the first week of school to assist your children in getting to the correct class line. I would ask that parents remain in their cars during carline and remember that your child should exit the car on the right side directly to the sidewalk.

Families with prekindergarten children (and their siblings and/or carpool buddies) should use the back of the school for drop off and pick up right from the first day of school. Teachers will be in the back of the school to be sure students get where they need to be.

Families who had vanpool slots last year should continue to use those same slots for afternoon pickup for the first week of school until new spots are assigned. The only exception to this is last year's kindergarten families - these families should pick up their children in the regular carline as the new kindergarten families will be assigned those slots immediately.
