# 2nd Quarter Closes January 27th

We have so many exciting events that are upcoming in the near future especially with the start of Catholic Schools Week on Sunday, January 29th. Please be sure to look at the information included here and on the school calendar in order to be up to date with all of the "goings-on" here at Holy Spirit.

The end of the 2nd quarter is a great time to take a look at your student's school supplies. Many students are arriving in classes without pens, pencils, paper, notebooks, etc. and students are telling teachers they have run out of or lost needed materials. Thank you for your assistance with this.

On Tuesday, January 24th we will have yearbook pictures taken of all clubs and sports teams associated with the school (for example, Chess Club, Student Council, CYO tennis, basketball, etc.). If your student will be involved with these pictures, please have them wear their dress uniform to school. Students who will be in pictures for CYO related sports should bring that uniform with them to school.

Please remember tomorrow, January 20th is a no school day in honor of the Inauguration. We will have an early dismissal on January 27th and Extended Day will close at 5:00 pm that day. I am hopeful that the registration materials for the 2017/2018 school year will go home on Monday, January 23rd. I apologize for the delay but was awaiting final approval of certain pieces.

You should have received a grocery bag and "needs" list of items. This collection is a part of our Catholic Schools Week celebration. Each year we choose a charitable organization to partner with in order to continue to instill the benefits of service to others with the students. This year we have chosen the Little Sisters of the Poor and we are blessed to have on the schedule a visit from the Sisters so that they can speak to the children about their own mission of service to others.

Our "Dimes for Devices" classroom challenge is off to a rousing start with Mrs. Crone's 3rd grade class already capturing 1st place by filling their class bottle today. The 2nd and 3rd place prizes are still out there waiting to be claimed and every class can earn a dress down day! When a bottle is filled with dimes it contains approximately \$500.00. If all twenty homerooms fill their bottle we will have an additional \$10,000 to put toward upgrades and purchases (a single ActiveBoard system can cost upwards of \$5000.00). I hope you are able to assist us in this endeavor.

A tremendous thank you to those families who have made donations to benefit our robotics program. Eight brand-new WeDo 2.0 robots arrived this week and eighteen Ozobot robots are in the ordering process. We cannot wait to continue to expand our students' knowledge of coding and to give them the opportunity to explore with these devices in connection with their curriculum standards.

The resource program at Holy Spirit school has been committed to supporting students with mild to moderate disabilities as well as students who need organizational or academic support for many years. Beginning in the fall of 2015, we expanded our resource program and welcomed students with Intellectual Disabilities and other more significant needs into our classrooms. This school year, 2016, we were able to continue to increase our expanded resource program with an addition of four new students. These students are in the classrooms with their peers where they are learning side by side. This inclusive environment benefits the students, the teachers, the staff, and the entire Holy Spirit School community.

This growth was made possible through the generous support of organizations like Porto Charities, Inc. and the Knights of Columbus Kovar and the funds raised through our 5K Spirit Run last year. Those funds were utilized to hire a part time reading specialist to the resource support team and to purchase technology dedicated to the needs of our students.

Holy Spirit School will be hosting another 5K Spirit Run on Saturday, May 20,2017 at Burke Lake to again raise funds and build community spirit. Despite the wet weather, last year's race was a great event. It created a wonderful opportunity for the parish community and the school community to come together as one. ## 2017 - 2018 Financial Aid Applications


Applications are now being accepted for the 2017 - 2018 school year.
