## Welcome 2017!

I certainly hope that everyone enjoyed the break from school and the students are back in the swing of schedules and school work.

Please note that we have one change to the school calendar that is in the near future. The Office of Catholic Schools has recommended that schools located within school districts that are closed for Inauguration Day be closed as well. **Therefore, Friday, January 20th will be a "No School" day for Holy Spirit.** This day will not have to be made up at the end of the year.

That same day, January 20th will still be the date when we close the Parent Portal for the 2nd quarter. The quarter ends the following Friday, January 27th. If students have outstanding work now would be the time for them to dialogue with their teachers.

The annual March for Life is Friday, January 27th. This is an early dismissal day for the school; Extended Day will be open but please note that it will close at 5:00 pm. The parish is sponsoring some 500+ guests for the March. Several of the groups will arrive late on Thursday evening and will depart Friday morning for the March. We hope for there to be minimal impact on our arrival line but please bear with us as we get the buses off the campus. Those same groups plus additional folks will arrive back here Friday afternoon and will stay overnight into Saturday.

I would certainly encourage you to participate as a family in the March. The parish will have buses going downtown. You may find more information and reserve a spot on the bus via the church website: holyspiritchurch.us.

Information regarding tuition rates for the 2017/2018 academic year are in the process of being finalized. Registration paperwork for current students will be coming home in about two weeks and will be due by January 31, 2017 (registration fee will remain the same: \$100/student). New student registration will begin on February 7, 2017.

### 2017 - 2018 Financial Aid Applications


Applications are now being accepted for the 2017 - 2018 school year.
