I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible next Wednesday for Lunch on the Lawn. This is an opportunity for you to come and have lunch with your children out on the front lawn of the school and spend a bit of time relaxing and listening to our wonderful student band. It is important to

Other accommodations will be made for these students. Those who suffer from allergies should take into consideration we will be outside most of the day.


