### Take a deep breath....

There are a few periods of time over the course of the year when the sheer amount of hustle and bustle take over and we all need to take an extra deep breath - we are just about there!

When we return from the Thanksgiving break (November 27 - November 29) we will have entered a season of anticipation and preparation - Advent!

In a simple way the word "Advent" comes from the Latin, *adventus* and although the word has several definitions - "develop", "set in ", "arise" - we commonly think of the word as meaning "coming" - and we turn our attention to preparing to celebrate the coming of Jesus into the world; we prepare to allow Jesus to come more fully into our lives; and we wait with anticipation for Jesus to come again as King and Judge.

It is with this sense of preparation that we couch all that we will do over the three weeks that we are in school in December prior to the Christmas break. Each Monday (December 2, 9, 16) we will have a prayer service to light the candles on the Advent wreath to help keep our hearts and minds on the importance of the season. Additionally, we will be decorating our Jesse Trees with class ornaments and learning each morning about each of the different symbols.

We will also extend our giving hearts by holding our annual toy drive to benefit Santa's Ride (see details below) which culminates in our Giving Mass on December 6th and by participating in the NJHS sponsored Christmas dress-down day with all

contributions (see below) benefiting Catholic Charities' We Care Week.

Mixed in to all of that of course are the K-4 Christmas Program, the 5th grade Nativity Pageant, Confessions, Adoration, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, and more. Please keep an eye on this newsletter and the school calendar for all of the goings-on.



Please donate a new, unwrapped toy, game, or book.




