As I mentioned last week as we seek to grow the robotics program at Holy Spirit we will be looking to purchase our own robots. If you would like to help fund such an endeavor, please contact me. Donations would be a tax deductible donation made to the school. To give some context to the purchase endeavor, a set of four of the smaller Lego WeDo 2.0 robots currently prices at \$750.00 (with additional shipping costs, etc.). In order to cover any of our classes and have ability to have students working in relatively small groups we are looking to start with eight to twelve robots. The complete class set would then be available for teachers to check-out and work with in their classrooms. What a great start that would be!

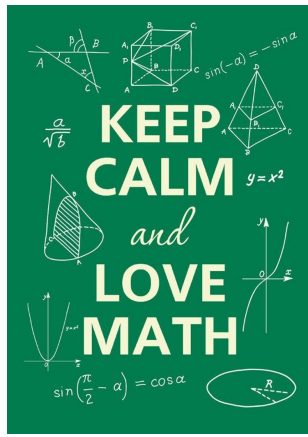


Parent-Teacher Conferences

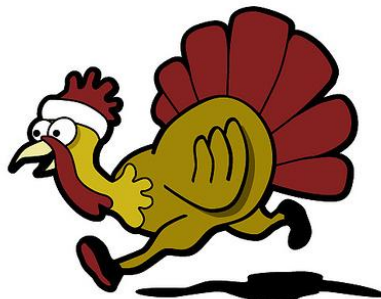
Once again, Holy Spirit is having its annual food drive. This year, we will be donating to Catholic Charities' St. Lucy Project. Due to increased demand, our assistance is needed to help resupply the food pantry with the following items:

- * Pre-K: macaroni & cheese kits
- * Kindergarten: instant potatoes
- * 1st grade: pasta
- * 2nd grade: tuna
- * 3rd grade: canned vegetables (corn, green beans)
- * 4th grade: canned fruit
- * 5th grade: cereal (large boxes)
- * 6th grade: jelly
- * 7th grade: peanut butter
- * 8th grade: canned meats (tuna, chicken)

Our goal is to collect 2016 items. Let's show our Holy Spirit School "Spirit" by reaching our goal!

You will receive your "blue bags" the week of October 17th and donations will be accepted until the morning of the 2nd of November.

FOR: Food for Others

COST: \$1.00. All money will be collected on Monday, Oct. 31st in homeroom.

For a \$1 dollar donation, students will pair with their mass buddies in a free throw competition. Volunteers will be stationed throughout the gym as older & younger students shoot baskets. Volunteers will assign points to shots-- 3 points for every basket made, 2 points for hitting the rim, backboard or net and 1 point for any missed attempts. Each team will get a total of 10 free throws.

The top mass buddy teams will compete in a final shoot out on Friday, November 4 at 1:30pm with the entire school cheering them on.

There will be a trophy for the winning team to be displayed in the front office.

All proceeds will purchase gift cards for Food for Others in conjunction with our Ton of Love food drive. These gift cards will help purchase food for at risk students.

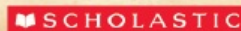
