October is the month of the Rosary

Over the Summer, we purchased 15 new icons of the Blessed Mother; you may recall seeing these in the photographs of our celebration of her birthday in September. The icons are now hanging in the hallway that leads to the cafeteria as October is one of the Marian months.

Each month throughout the year, we will have a short assembly highlighting a different title of Mother Mary in order to teach the children more about her and the special and important role she has in our Faith.

The first of these assemblies will be Monday, October 7th as we recognize the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Certainly, all are welcome to join us at 8:30 am in the gym.

Please remember that October 7th is an early release day in order to provide the faculty extended time to work on the DFE requirements. Extended Day will be open. (Note that there is funeral on Monday morning thus challenging the car line once again.) In connection with the DFE, thank you to those who have returned the parent survey. For those who would like to participate (I would encourage everyone to so do), the surveys are needed by tomorrow, October 4th so that we can cull all of the data and incorporate it into the self-study.

The 8th grade students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation next week on Wednesday, October 9th. Please pray for them, their sponsors, and their families in these final days leading up to this wonderful celebration.

Please also pray for all of the principals in the Diocese of Arlington as we go on retreat next week (October 10 & 11).

Interims for the 1st Trimester will go home next Friday, October 11th. As a reminder, interims are only for students in grades 3-8. A paper interim will go home with students who have a 75% or below in any core academic subject or a "1" or an "X" in a Specials class. The online parent portal is always accessible to parents of students in grade 3-8.

The annual Scholastic Book Fair also opens on October 11th; see below for additional information.

Monday, October 14th is a no school day in observance of Columbus Day.

Formation in Christian Chastity

As mentioned in last week's newsletter, during the week of October 14th all students in grades 1-8 will have presented to them the information included in the Diocesan Formation in Christian Chastity program. This is an opt-out program meaning that families must specifically sign and turn in the waiver asking for their child to be exempted from the program.

In PowerLearning on the Family Information page there is a tab for Formation in Christian Chastity. The form is there. For those looking for information about the program, there is a link on the same page which takes you to the Diocese of Arlington website. Please note that for many of the grades levels the same lesson is used but the focus of the lesson changes as the child gets older. If you look at the parent letter for the grade level under the section, "What could parents teach to [insert grade here] Graders?" that will give a better explanation of what is being taught. For instance, in 1st grade, the focus is on creation, in 2nd grade, the theme is the human person as a child of God, etc.

This program is different from the middle school program on Human Growth & Sexuality.






