It is vital that we receive all of the forms but in particular the Emergency Care form. We are minus 80+ of those forms. Please take the time to fill out everything and return immediately.



Carpool Reminders...

Carpool is always a challenge the first few days of school but it does get better quickly. If everyone could please follow the below reminders it would be a great help:

During morning drop-off, no students should be dropped off prior to 7:45 am. Teachers do not go on duty outside until 7:45 am (please note we work by the bell/clock within the school). No students should be dropped off in the upper parking lot and allowed to walk down the sidewalk to the front of the school. I know everyone is busy and has somewhere to be but for the safety of everyone involved all cars should come through the front car line. (This excludes Prekindergarten families who drop-off in the rear of the school.)

The drop-off line moves much faster if students are ready to go when you reach the sidewalk. Parents should stay in the car and allow teachers to assist the students. All students must exit on the right side of the car so they step immediately onto the sidewalk. Regardless of where your child's class linesup, please have your child get out of the car at the first spot at which you stop along the sidewalk; do not make multiple drop-offs or stops.

In the afternoon, please be sure that you are filling in one line at a time and I ask that you be cognizant of not cutting into a line in front of others who have been patiently waiting.

Parents may not park in the upper lot and walk down to retrieve students from the front of the school. Again, I understand that many are in a hurry and have places to be but for safety and out of fairness all should wait in the carpool line

As after school activities begin and more children begin attending Extended Day, the carpool line will return to its usual 10-15 minute "event".

Both nights will begin promptly at 7:00 pm.




