School Safety Drills Inclement Weather

Of the many and varied responsibilities of the administration and faculty one of the most important is the safety of the students at Holy Spirit. In order to be as well prepared as possible for various emergencies, we routinely drill for different scenarios.

Since the beginning of the school year, we have had one fire drill a week. This routine is followed for the first month of school and thereafter we have a fire drill once a month. We do our best to vary the days and times of the drills in order to give us teaching opportunities with the students as well as for us to consistently assess our procedures.

In addition to a fire drill this week, we also had our first "Secure the building" drill. The students were apprised ahead of time for this first lockdown drill of the year, again, so that we can teach them what will happen.

Next week we will have what I consider to be the most "emotionally charged" drill which is the intruder in the building drill. Again, the students will know ahead of time that this is coming and walked through the procedures by their teachers. If your student comes home at the end of the week discussing the drill, please reassure them that the purpose of the drills is to keep everyone safe and secure.

We will hold various other drills, hurricane, earthquake, etc. over the course of the year.

And then there is inclement weather. With all of the talk of Hurricane Florence over the course of the week, I would be remiss if I did not remind everyone that Holy Spirit follows Fairfax County Public Schools with regard to school closures caused by inclement weather. I would highly recommend that you sign up for alerts from FCPS and be mindful of watching the local morning news or listening to a local radio station if there is ever a question as to the possibility of weather closures.

A couple of calendar reminders:

Friday, September 21st is an early dismissal day for everyone; Extended Day is open and the teachers have professional development for the afternoon.

Fall Yearbook pictures are scheduled for Tuesday, September 25th; picture order forms went home with the children earlier in the week.

Wednesday, September 26th at 7:00 pm in the school library will be the middle school parent information meeting regarding the human growth and sexuality classes. Please look for a separate email from me to the middle school families regarding this program and meeting.




