This week we embarked on our first week of Scantron Testing with the 6th & 7th grade classes. All went well and I am, again, indebted to the fundraising efforts of the PTO over the years as the Chromebooks have made the testing experience easily managed with student schedules.

With regard to the car lines (both morning and afternoon), we have lengthened the area in which cars are able to pull up in front of the school - if you are the front car as the group pulls in please be sure to round the curve and pull up as far as the swinging "Stop Here" sign. I would also ask that you please be cognizant of leaving large gaps between cars so that we can maximize the space. Remember that your student does not have to be dropped off directly in front of the area where his/her class lines up - when cars make multiple stops it slows us down.

To reiterate, please do not drop your child off in the upper lot in the morning the line is moving pretty quickly now and all families are expected to drop-off in the proper, designated places.

Lastly, please be sure to put down your cell phone when driving through the car line so that all attention is put on the students and cars.

Changes to Extended Day Billing

In our continuing efforts to automate payments to the school, Extended Day billing for both the morning and afternoons will be done through the same platform on which families make tuition payments, Smart.

The payment draw will take place on the same schedule as each family's tuition payment. Families will receive, from Smart, an email indicating what the additional amount will be for the billing cycle.

Please note that at the end of the year for tax purposes, families will be able to access the amount paid for Extended Day services via the family's Smart account.
