#### Is it Fall or is it Summer?

The weather has certainly been up and down of late, fluctuating between hot and cold. Inevitably I end up with questions from parents about uniforms during this transition time. The formal date for the transition to the Winter uniform is Monday, November 4th but please remember that you have the option to have your children wear the sweatpants and sweatshirts for P.E., etc. even now on the days when the temperature is a bit chillier.

A reminder that tomorrow is an early release day (11:30 am) in order for Diocesan mandated teacher professional development time. Extended Day will be open.

Please look for the **Design for Excellence (DFE) Parent Survey** coming home tomorrow, Friday, September 27th. These will be sent in an envelope and sent with the youngest or only child in each family. Please return the completed survey in the provided envelope by Friday, October 4th. Thank you in advance for your participation.

During the week of October 14th all students in grades 1-8 will have presented to them the information included in the **Diocesan Formation in Christian Chastity program.** This is an **opt-out** program meaning that families must specifically sign and turn in the waiver asking for their child to be exempted from the program.

In PowerLearning on the Family Information page there is a tab for Formation in Christian Chastity. The form is there. For those looking for information about the

program, there is a link on the same page which takes you to the Diocese of Arlington website. Please note that for many of the grades levels the same lesson is used but the focus of the lesson changes as the child gets older. If you look at the parent letter for the grade level under the section, "What could parents teach to [insert grade here] Graders?" that will give a better explanation of what is being taught. For instance, in 1st grade, the focus is on creation, in 2nd grade, the theme is the human person as a child of God, etc.

This program is different from the middle school program on Human Growth & Sexuality which is an **opt-in** program. Please see the information in the section below.

Both **Trunk or Treat** (sponsored by the PTO) and the Student Council's **Spirit Week** are right around the corner. Information on Spirit Week will be forthcoming shortly. Links to sign up for a spot and/or to volunteer for Trunk or Treat are below.

And because Christmas will be here in the blink of an eye - the link to sign-up to sell Christmas trees as a part of the PTO's fundraiser is below.

A final reminder that this Sunday, September 29th is the **Diocesan Mass for Disabilities** hosted here at Holy Spirit Church. The Mass time is 10:30 am and it would be wonderful to see as many of our school families as possible present to support our students who will be participating.



Classes will visit the Book Fair for a thirty-minute session.


Students may bring money or make wish lists during their visit.


Individual students may return to the Book Fair to make additional purchases with the permission of the teacher.


