I finally feel like I can say we "are back"! The students seem to be in the flow of the school routines and as I visit classrooms there is much learning and activity going on throughout the building. After school activities are getting into full swing and as you can see from below the school, parish, and community have many announcements and opportunities to get involved in so many different events.

Thank you to those families who attended the Back to School Night presentations. A special thank you to the PTO Executive Board officers who attended each night in order to introduce themselves to you. I continue to urge all of the families to be as active as possible with the PTO events and committees. Not only are these a great way to get to know other parents in our school community but everything the PTO does has a direct impact on each of the students here.

As I mentioned in my remarks both nights, Holy Spirit School is not a "true tuition" school which means you, as parents, do not pay the full cost of what is required to educate your student and run the school building. Although the number can vary slightly from year to year, the 2017 statistics show that the cost/student was \$7,446.00. Only due to the financial investment of the parish to the school and private donations are we able to keep tuition lower than true cost and to continue to provide tuition reductions for families with multiple children. The PTO and the fundraising activities that take place over the course of the year also assist with closing the gap between charged and actual tuition costs.

I am looking forward to an exciting and busy year and hope that you will all visit

the PTO Volunteer Fair on Tuesday, September 11th at 7:00 pm in the school gymnasium. There are so many opportunities to volunteer your time and talent to our school community.

A couple of reminders:

On Friday, September 7th following our 9:00 am school Mass we will be praying the rosary in honor of the Blessed Mother's birthday. Please join us if you can (with sunny weather we will pray out on the front lawn).
