Not knowing what this crazy March weather will do, Interim Reports will be coming home with students in grades 3-8 today for students who are receiving a 75% or below in a core academic subject or an "X" or a "1" in a Specials class. All other student grades for those in grades 3-8 are available via the Parent Portal.

With regard to the portal, please note that as a result of the last Diocesan-wide software update some parents are not receiving the email notifications they set up when they created their account. A reminder that if you intend to apply for tuition assistance for the 2016/2017 school year, the application and all supporting documentation must be completed and uploaded to Smart Aid by March 14th. 
Holy Spirit School's Spring Talent Showcase & Raffle

Cor Unum for Boys! Select Fridays before youth group from 6-7:30 pm


