Happy St. Patrick's Day! The students, faculty and staff had a wonderful day celebrating the Irish in us all. We also had fun "surprising" Father O'Donohue for his birthday today. As a community we are truly blessed to have him at the helm - his dedication to Catholic education and to this school is remarkable.

I am excited to announce three new programs coming to Holy Spirit. I also cannot stress enough that these programs would not be possible without the tremendous financial support of the PTO.

First, the school will be purchasing an annual site license for IXL. Some families may already be familiar with this program, but for those who are not it is a web-based program which enhances student learning. Due to its adaptive nature, teachers will be able to provide both remediation and enrichment work on specific skills that can be tailored to the needs of the individual learner. A couple of our math classes have been piloting the program and we've received positive feedback from both parents

and students.

Second, Holy Spirit will be including robotics as a part of our curriculum enhancements for next year. We have teamed with Fun Bot Lab to offer a comprehensive elementary robotics learning experience for our students. Through professional development with teachers and direct robotic insertions we will be providing our students with an exciting and purposefully designed program.

And it gets even better! Along with the robotics experience, the PTO will be bringing 100 iPads into our community to facilitate the robotics program, enhance the curricula and provide even more opportunities to individualize and energize the learning of our 21st Century students.

Additionally, for those who would like a jump start on robotics, Fun Bot Lab will be hosting a Robotics and Media Camp for grades K - 6 here at Holy Spirit this summer. Please see the information below.

Holy Spirit is a dynamic and growing school and I am most pleased to play a small part in moving us always forward.
