A little extra...

A reminder that final report cards and/or transcripts will not be released to/for families who have a pending financial obligation to the school. Those obligations may include tuition, morning/extended care, library, cafeteria, PSSC hours, etc.

Thank you to those families who have followed-up regarding the PSSC hours. Again, you should have received via your children notices with regard to PSSC hours. Families who have completed the 20 hour commitment were sent a small slip of paper indicating that the hours are finished. Families with outstanding hours received a letter in an envelope indicating the number of hours which are recorded, the remaining balance of hours, and the fee that is being assessed base on that balance. If you feel something is in error or you

are unsure of the status of your family, please contact the appropriate PSSC coordinator. If you have additional hours to log, please submit to the PTO via the school webpage.

For families who have found that they are moving out of the area and your students will not be returning to Holy Spirit, I certainly wish you well. Please contact Mrs. Laclede when you have obtained a Release of Records for the new school so that we may send along needed information.

Morning Care/Extended Day

In order to best ensure that there are no outstanding balances when the school year comes to a close, billing for Extended Day will be broken into groups:

- 1. 8th grade
- 2. Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten
- 3. 1st through 7th grade.

Payment procedures will be as follows:

- 8th grade students will receive an invoice on Monday, June 6th, with a payment due date of Wednesday, June 8.
- PreK and Kindergarteners will receive an invoice on Monday, June 8th with a payment of Friday, June 10.
- Any use of Morning Care/Extended Day during the week of June 6 for these groups will be on a "pay as you go" basis.
- Students in grades 1-7 will receive an invoice on Monday June 13, with a payment due date of Thursday June 16.
- Any use of Morning Care/Extended Day during the week of June 13 will be on a "pay as you go" basis.
