#### **EXTENDED DAY**

**Afternoon Extended Care** for all grades will begin in the cafeteria. Grade levels may begin using Afternoon Extended Care on the following dates:

Grades 1-8 – may begin using Extended Day on Wednesday, August 24<sup>th</sup> Kindergarten – may begin using Extended Day on Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup> PreKindergarten – may begin using Extended Day on Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup> Afternoon Extended Day is closed completely on Friday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> due to the early dismissal prior to the Labor Day weekend.


#### Headphone/Earbuds

For health purposes we are requesting that all students provide their own headphones/earbuds.




