One of several "new" items this year includes the Diocese of Arlington moving to a new standardized testing platform, NWEA Map. Additional information on the test will be provided, but it falls in line with what the Diocese has done for several years now in that it is an online adaptive test that is given to students in grades 3-7. We will continue to test in the areas of

mathematics, English grammar, and reading comprehension. The first testing window will be in September so that we can get a "check in" of where students are and use that information to help inform instruction in the classroom.

We look forward to seeing everyone next week on Tuesday, August 23rd for the Meet Your Teacher events. As a reminder, families with last names that begin with letters from A-M are invited to join us from 11:00 am - 12:00 noon. Connect1

This application can be accessed on a smartphone or computer.

- · It will provide a central location for families to see all the volunteer opportunities available to them, both school-wide and for their children's classes (replacing the need for individual signup genius accounts).
- · It will provide a way to automatically track PSSC hours based on event signups (and adjust that time as needed).
- It will provide an electronic version of the school directory, including class lists and parent contact information. Information can be updated in real-time, ensuring information for students

who join school mid-year is readily available, and information for families who move during the school year is quickly available as well.

It provides a prayer board to request and answer prayers for our community.



Registering for Connect 1 at Holy Spirit School

How to sign up for an account on Connect1:

- 1. On your computer, go to https://app.connect1.io
- 2. Click the green bar that says "Sign up (School Code).



- 3. Enter your email address. Enter our school code, which is I41VP6. (Are you both a teacher and a parent at the school? You'll need to set up two accounts. One using your "holyspiritfiames.org" email account for you role as a teacher, and your personal one for your role as a parent!)
- 4. This will open a new page where you enter your name, role and password. For Role, select "Parent/Community Member". (Unless you are a teacher creating your account with your "holyspiritflames.org" account. In that case, please select "Faculty/School Employee".) Click Submit when you are done.
- Anew page opens. AConfirmation Code will be sent to your email. Copy that confirmation code and paste it into this page. Click Confirm.
- This brings you back to the Sign In page. Enter your email address and newly created password to open the app.


