The Advent Season is about reflecting on how we can prepare our hearts and homes for Christ's birth in the world as it is today. It is a time for us to remember, through prayer, reflections, special music, and good deeds what the true meaning of Jesus' birth is. The Advent

season invites us to step away from what can be a frenzied time of parties and shopping to consider how we commemorate the birth of Jesus, one of the holiest times in our faith. It is also a time to reflect on the triumphant return of Jesus at the second coming.

Our annual toy drive ends tomorrow, Friday, December 2nd!


We currently have 379 donated toys.







### Wednesday Night **Bible Study** With Father O'Donohue




What is the importance and meaning of islands in Isaiah? Our class will explain this and other passages as we continue through our journey through the book of Isaiah.
