The tuition rates and other information for the 2024/2025 academic year were sent home yesterday with the youngest or only child in your family.


Families interested in applying for tuition assistance for the 2024/2025 academic year, the FACTS application is open. The deadline for applying is March 13, 2024.



3rd Grade- "Town speople"




Please remember that you must be fully compliant with the Child Protection policies of the Diocese in order to perform recess duty and to volunteer for activities where students are present.
