





DRIVE BOOKS? Did you know that the Diocese has two free medical clinics?

Yes, they are The Mother of Mercy clinics in Manassas and Woodbridge

The clinics' mission is to engage the community to provide free, quality healthcare to low income adults who are uninsured or underinsured in Prince William County. The clinic does not charge patients receiving basic medical care. All the doctors and nurses who work at the clinic volunteer their time to provide this free medical care. The clinic is also a portal toward other necessary integrated services that Catholic Charities provides, such as counseling, emergency financial and food assistance and referrals for workforce development and immigration support.

We would like to provide children's books to families in the waiting room while waiting to be seen.

If you have some **slightly used children's books** to donate, we would love to supply the clinics. Pre-pandemic, books were provided and children could take them home. Therefore, we will be asking for more books from time to time to fill this need.
