9:00 AM Mass (in the church) followed by a reception


Grandparents and their grandchildren should arrive together in time for the 9:00 am Mass and go directly to the church.

While preparing for the current academic year, Holy Spirit was faced with the challenge of revamping the school's hot lunch program. In order to conform to the advice of the Diocesan Chancery Offices, the parish/school no longer rents out the kitchen space to a catering company and thus, after interviews with several companies, entered into a year-long arrangement with School Eatery to provide student lunches.

The platform used by School Eatery is similar to those of other companies in the same industry (Yay Lunch; Fairfax Food Service) and pricing was found to be similar.

We know the change was a big one for our returning families and got off to a bit of a rocky start. Having settled into the year and new platform, and as said at the start of the year, we are seeking feedback from the parent community about the experience with School Eatery in order to guide us in discussions with the company and for future decisions regarding a hot lunch program.


#### Doodle for Google Contest 2023
