 $\underline{\mathrm{Why:}}$ A gift of a newborn kit provides struggling mothers with clothes, diapers and other items to keep their new babies safe and healthy. These basic items provide mothers with the tools and supplies they would otherwise not have access to.

Stella Marina, an Operation Starfish project, was founded in 2014 to help **provide** clean **birthing kits to the midwives in northern Haiti.** With the support of Food For The Poor, they are able to ship the kits and other supplies to Cap Haitian, Haiti. The shipping container with our kits will be going to Haiti in the spring.


