Nothing But Faith Day

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

Welcome Back!

I hope that everyone enjoyed the time away from school and that everyone is refreshed and ready to tackle the "second" part of the school year.

One of the goals that the faculty set for itself is to increase the retreat experiences for our students. What we settled on and are building are what are being called "Nothing But Faith Day"; the first of these will be tomorrow, Friday, January 6th.

We will be learning about and exploring the Epiphany over the course of our day.

The day will begin with Deacon Grodek reading to the children a book entitled "The Wise Men Who Found Christmas" by Raymond Arroyo. The book will help us set the stage with the children and we will use the three themes of "follow the light", "go to the King", and "discover the truth" thoughout the day.

We will attend Friday Mass as usual, have snack with buddies, and then break into groups (PreK and K; Grades 1-2; Grades 3-5; Grades 6-8) to work through activities and challenges that we hope will enhance the students knowledge of the Epiphany and allow them the opportunity to realize the personal gifts that they can bring to the Christ Child each day.

After lunch (all students will eat at the same time in their homeroom classrooms; hot lunches, etc will be delivered to the classrooms) we will gather again in the gym and hear about the connection of closing the Christmas season and opening the season of Mardi Gras. Students will be provided King Cake from Haydel's Bakery.

The last portion of the day will find us "going to the King" as we head back to the church as a whole school. During our time there, students will present at the creche the gifts they put together in the morning; we will pray the Rosary in honor of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI; we will hear the Epiphany readings and Father O'Donohue will join us to speak to the children about the themes and importance of the Epiphany in the history and life of the Church.

We do truly hope this is a special day for everyone.

(*For students who have food allergies, information was sent out by homeroom teachers. The snack in the morning will be Cheez Its and water. The King Cakes do contain sugar, salt, shortening, eggs, yeast, milk, flour, and lemon, orange, vanilla, or butter flavoring.)

Registration for 2023/2024 academic year

Informationg regarding registration for the 2023/2024 academic year went home prior to the Christmas break.

Families who intend for their children to return to Holy Spirit next year should return the provided financial contract by tomorrow, Friday, January 6th.

We had also asked that families update their demographic information in PowerSchool. We are aware that the site is not working. This is an issue on the Office of Catholic Schools side of things and we are awaiting word that it is open and working properly.

In the meantime, we will consider students re-registered with the returning of the financial contract.

The re-registration fee of \$100.00/student will be charged via each family's FACTS account.

Acceptances for new students in prekindergarten and kindergarten have already begun. Acceptances for new students in grades 1-8 will begin on January 9, 2023.

March for Life Friday, January 20, 2023

The annual March for Life rally and walk will take place in Washington D.C. on Friday, January 20, 2023. Despite the Supreme Court decision earlier in the year in the Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization, there is still much work to be done to protect the rights of the unborn.

If your family has never participated in the March for Life, I would encourage you to prayerfully consider attending. Information is below regarding the offerings from the Holy Spirit Parish for this day.

As had been traditional prior to COVID, the parish will be hosting a number of out of state groups overnight in the school building.

As a result, Father has cancelled school for Friday, January 20th. Please be sure you note this on your calendar.

As a school community, we will have our own March for Life on Thursday, January 19th as we will have an outdoor Rosary over the course of the afternoon led by the 8th grade students. Parents are certainly welcome to attend; watch for a schedule of when particular classes will make there way outside to participate.

Stella Marina, an Operation Starfish project, was founded in 2014 to help **provide clean birthing kits to the midwives in northern Haiti.** With the support of Food For The Poor, they are able to ship the kits and other supplies to Cap Haitian, Haiti. The shipping container with our kits will be going to Haiti in the spring.






