
An Invitation to All Rising 5th and 6th Graders To Read with the Battle of the Books Club 2023-2024

- 2. Click the green bar that says "Sign up (School Code).

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- 3. Enter your email address. Enter our school code, which is L41VP6. (Are you both a teacher and a parent at the school? You'llneed to set up two accounts. One using your "holyspiritfames.org" email account for your ole as a teacher, and your personal one for your role as a parent!)
- 4. This will open a new page where you enter your name, role and password. For Role, select "Parent/Community Member". (Unless you are a teacher creating your account with your "holyspiritflames.org" account. In that case, please select "Faculty/School Employee".) Click Submit when you are done.
- Anew page opens. AConfirmation Code will be sent to your email. Copy that confirmation code and paste it into this page. Click Confirm.
- This brings you back to the Sign In page. Enter your email address and newly created password to open the app.
