The waning days of Summer

As we continue to prepare for the opening of school, I know that the topic on most everyone's minds is that of the wearing of masks. Information is coming in daily and, I will be honest, I am currently out of the State and so have not processed all that has been made available via the Virginia Department of Health and the Fairfax County Health Department among other entities.

Like most schools in the Diocese of Arlington, Holy Spirit is in the position of having to weigh the information across a multitude of age "situations." With Holy Spirit having students from 4 to 14 years old it means looking at decision impacts not just in terms of vaccinated versus unvaccinated students and staff, but also possible impacts to the licensing for the prekindergarten and extended day programs and everything in between. It also means considering quarantine expectations should positive cases present themselves.

With that being said, know that the intent is to go into the year with as much being "back to normal" as possible. We will make use of the entire building with students moving to the music and art rooms, the computer lab, the cafeteria, etc. The middle school students will be moving classrooms as they have traditionally done and we will be attending Mass in the church each week.

Students will not be required to wear masks when outdoors.

I will be returning to the school building next week and will provide information as soon as feasibly possible regarding the ultimate question of masks in the building; I thank you for your

patience.

IXL Math assignments for students in rising K-8 were included with each student's report card.






