We have launched into Trimester 3! It is hard to believe that we are in the final stretch in terms of marking periods! It is important for students to stay focused and now might be a great time to be sure they still have all of the supplies that they need for their academic classes.

We will switch over to the Spring uniform when we return from the Easter break, Monday, April 8th. Reminders
