Holy Week

Our journey this Lent has brought us to the edge of the start of Holy Week. This Sunday is Palm Sunday and we will begin the most holy week of the year.

I hope that you will center your week around prayer as family and prioritize attending the Triduum Services provided by the parish. Setting that example for your children is an important part of their faith journey and helps to put into context and action everything they are learning about our Catholic Faith.

This Lent, as a part of my own journey, I have been reading <u>33 Days to Euchartistic Glory</u> by Matthew Kelly and deepening my relationship with Jesus through His True Presence in the Most Holy Eucharist. The selection for last night connected itself to the Holy Moments program we have been teaching and trying to live throughout this school year.

"It's time for your life to make sense. Once we discover that some moments are holy, some moments are unholy, and our choices can guide a moment in either direction, life finally begins to make sense.

This is no small thing. Most people in the modern secular world cannot make sense of life. The culture has exiled them from God, religion, and spirituality. So, each day is a frustrated attempt to put together the jigsaw puzzle of life without crucial pieces. And the more disconnected from God our lives become, the more meaningless life becomes.

Holy Moments inject divine meaning and purpose into every moment of our lives. Meaning

is crucial to our health and happiness. We cannot thrive as human beings without it. And we cannot live a meaningful life by filling our life with trivial things and meaningless activities. Holy Moments solve the meaninglessness of our lives."

You are the primary educators of your children. Help them to make sense of life. Place them in front of our Lord in the Tabernacle as often as possible. Help them to prioritize having a relationship with Jesus. Model that for them as they watch each and every thing that you do and as they listen to each and every thing that you say to them and to others.

May your Holy Week be meaningful and fill your soul with grace and joy.

We are looking forward to our annual Father's Day Mass tomorrow, March 22nd; see details below. This is a wonderful day for us to honor the important men in the lives of our children and we choose this timing in order to coincide with the Feast of St. Joseph.

The 8th Grade will be gifting to the school community the prayer of Living Stations of the Cross on Thursday, March 28th at 9:00 am. All are welcome.

Holy Thursday is March 28th and is an early dismissal day with no afternoon Extended Day. The school is closed for Good Friday and we will have our Easter break the week of April 1st.

When we return from the break, students will move into the Spring uniform.

Spring pictures will be taken on April 18th. All students will have their picture taken. This is a BEST DRESS picture. There should not be any students in shorts, jeans, t-shirts, leggings, or very short skirts/dresses. Although sandals look really cute with Spring dresses, for safety reasons students must be in footwear that is close-toed and that has a back to it.

Reminders

In order to volunteer with any youth in the Arlington Diocese, you must be Child Protection Compliant.

Parents or legal guardians of each student(s) registered at Holy Spirit School are required to earn a minimum of 20 hours (40 PSSC points) per family or 10 hours (20 PSSC points) for single parent families (single parent families also include families with a deployed spouse) of combined volunteer service during the current school year.
