Saturday, May 20th is the annual 5K Spirit Run in support of our Resource Department and all of the great work that is done with students across the entirety of our school community. Have you registered?





Come together in silence.

Saint Teresa of Calcutta said, "We need to find God, and he cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence." Once a week, turn off the television, computers, video games and telephones for fifteen minutes. Sit in silence together and listen for God's voice.




