We will light our Advent Wreath and celebrate the beginning of Advent with a prayer service on Monday, November 28th at 8:30 am in the gym. All are welcome.



Parent Volunteers: A signup will be in Connect 1 to volunteer to help during the PE classes.

For a \$1-dollar donation, students will pair with their mass buddies in a free throw competition. Volunteers will be stationed throughout the gym to help keep score. Volunteers will assign points to shots-- 3 points for every basket made, 2 points for hitting the rim, backboard or net and 1 point for any missed attempts. 
A youth organization sponsored by the Holy Spirit Knights of Columbus for girls ages 10-18.
