The date for that being posted to family FACTS accounts will be in the information that comes to you regarding tuition. For those families who are not returning for next year, the packet will include an Intent Not to Return form that we ask that you complete and return.

Families interested in applying for tuition assistance for the 2024/2025 academic year, the FACTS application is open. The deadline for applying is March 13, 2024.

Evans for organizing this annual charitable drive.



3rd Grade- "Town speople"




#### **Gingerbread House Decorating** (1 point/30 mins volunteered)


