For those new to our community, the goal each year is to donate a literal TON of food to the St. Lucy Food Project. I really encourage you to put the themes for the different days of Spirit Week on your calendar and let your kiddos start planning now.

Friday, October 27th is a no school day for students as it a Diocesan professional development day for the teachers. But don't stray far from home as that evening is the PTO's annual Trunk or Treat event! This is a terrific evening of fun for everyone and I

encourage you to sign up for a slot and come out and show off your decorated car.

Parent/Teacher Conferences will take place on Thursday, November 9 and Friday, November 10. All parents are asked to plan for a conference with your child's HOMEROOM teacher. In the next couple of weeks a Sign-Up Genius will be sent out to families in order to reserve your timeslot. Parents may choose an in-person conference or one via Zoom.

Thurday, November 9th will be an early dismissal day (Extended Day is open) and Friday, November 10th is a no school day for students so that we can hold these conferences.

## **Formation in Christian Chastity**

Each year, we are required by the Office of Catholic Schools and the Office of Child Protection and Safety for the Diocese to present to students in Grades 1-8 the Formation in Christian Chastity program. This year, this will take place during the week of November 6th.

I encourage all parents to review the materials that will be used for the lessons by accessing them at the link below.

This is an OPT-OUT program meaning that all students will receive the information unless a parent specifically opts their child out via the below form.

Again, I encourage you to take time to review the materials, before making that decision. Please note that for Grades 1-4 the information is repetitive from year to year.



- 6-8th @ 1:30-2:30p (Color Run)


