The 8th graders had the first of the high school visits this week - St. Paul VI High School and Bishop O'Connell High School. It is always exciting to see which of our alumni will return for the visit - they are all so grown-up! It is wonderful to hear how they are doing and how they affirm the good work that the teachers across the school have done and the impact that their time at Holy Spirit has had on them.

Please pray for the 8th grade class and their parents as they enter this time of decision as they visit schools, submit applications, participate in the High School Placement Test, and begin to solidify what their hopes are for the next four years of their academic career.

Thoughtful Moments

St. John XXIII
Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was born to a poor farming family in Bergamo, Italy. His ordination as a priest in 1904 began a lifetime serving the Church as the bishop's secretary, a military chaplain, cardinal-patriarch of Venice, and finally, as "Good Pope John." He often visited the poor, the sick and prisoners. He worked to uphold their dignity and improved relations with the Eastern Church. He is remembered for opening the Second Vatican Council. He died in 1963.

The Guardian Angels
Guardian angels are "angels assigned to protect and intercede for each person" (Catechism of the Catholic Church #336). The intervention of the angels on our behalf is one way God takes care of us. Pray the Guardian Angel prayer with children often.

"Jesus reveals the nature of God as that of a Father who never gives up until he has forgiven the wrong and overcome rejection with compassion and mercy." Pope Francis

Fall saints for a good school year

The saints in heaven help us on Earth with their prayers. We can also follow their examples to heaven. Through the autumn months, these saints can be beacons of light for children:

St. Thomas Aquinas is the patron of students. Brilliant but humble, he became one of the greatest minds of the Church, studying, teaching, and defending the Faith. He began study with a prayer: "Point out the beginning, direct the progress, and help in completion. Through Christ our Lord. Amen."

St. Sebastian, named patron of athletes, bravely endured suffering for the faith. Young athletes can ask him to inspire their strength, good sportsmanship, and self-discipline in their faith and on the field.

St. John Paul II, patron of World Youth Day and Catholic Sports, was born Karol Wojtyła in Poland. He lost his mother, father, and older brother before his 21st birthday. His promising academic career was cut short by the outbreak of World War II. After enrolling in a secret seminary in Krakow, he was ordained a priest in 1946 and eventually became one of the longest serving popes in Church history.

St. Philip Neri is patron of holy friendships. A valuable part of our school experience is learning to make friends. Call on the intercession of St. Philip Neri when navigating friendship challenges and to find holy friends.


Why Do Catholics Do That?

Traditionally attributed to the Dominican Order, the Rosary is a set of prayers that focuses on the mysterious events in the lives of Jesus and Mary. Several Marian apparitions and countless saints and popes have recommended the Rosary as the "powerhouse" of devotion. Many mistake it as Marian devotion, but the prayer is actually a meditation on Jesus' life through Mary's eyes. Meditating on the prayers and mysteries of our faith opens us to graces that make us more Christ-like.

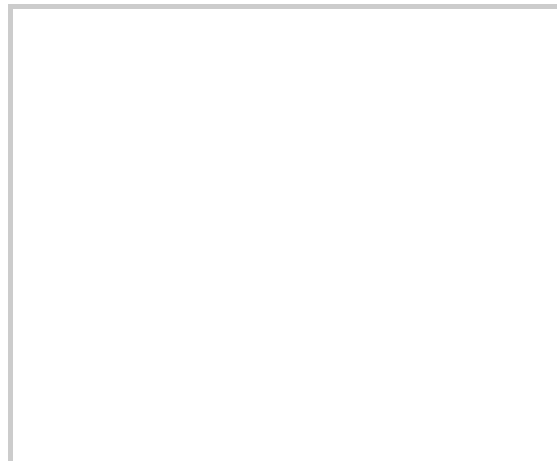
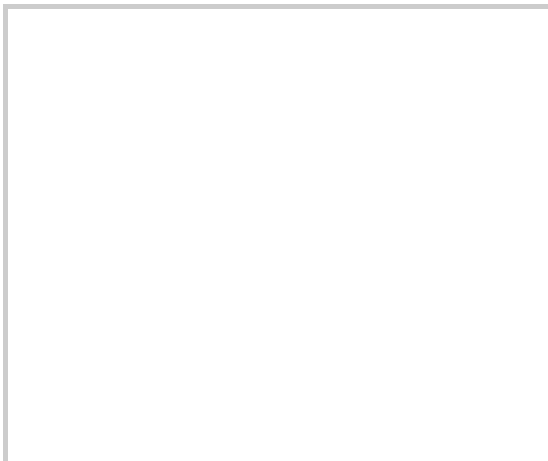



Registering for Connect 1 at Holy Spirit School

How to sign up for an account on Connect1:

1. On your computer, go to <https://app.connect1.io>
2. Click the green bar that says "Sign up (School Code)".



3. Enter your email address. Enter our school code, which is L41VP6. (Are you both a teacher and a parent at the school? You'll need to set up two accounts. One using your "holyspiritflames.org" email account for your role as a teacher, and your personal one for your role as a parent!)
4. This will open a new page where you enter your name, role and password. For Role, select "Parent/Community Member". (Unless you are a teacher creating your account with your "holyspiritflames.org" account. In that case, please select "Faculty/School Employee".) Click Submit when you are done.
5. A new page opens. A Confirmation Code will be sent to your email. Copy that confirmation code and paste it into this page. Click Confirm.
6. This brings you back to the Sign In page. Enter your email address and newly created password to open the app.

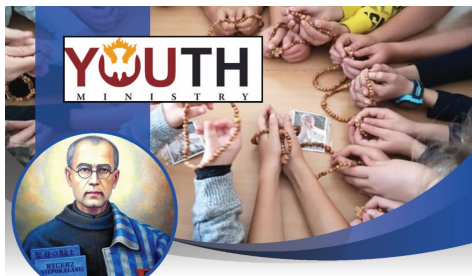
Mass for People with Disabilities Sunday, October 8, 2023



The Holy Spirit Women's Council is pleased to host Deacon Mark Arbeen on October 14 after the 9am Mass in the Quinn Room. All women and men of the parish are invited to here Deacon Mark talk about his Spiritual Journey.

Before entering college, Deacon Mark spent 8 years in the U.S. Navy on active duty, where he was a Lay Chaplain for the Episcopal Church, and then 12 years in the Naval Reserve. He then attended the University of Illinois and earned a degree in economics. In 2002 Deacon Mark began attending Saturday Mass while still attending his Episcopal parish on Sundays. In 2009 Pope Benedict offered Anglicans a way to enter the Catholic Church while keeping much of their liturgy and customs. For years Deacon Mark served at Our Lady of Hope Catholic Church using the new Divine Worship Missal and the Anglican Patrimony as approved by Rome.

In 2018 he was ordained a Permanent Deacon in the Roman Catholic Church with an active ministry in law enforcement. He serves as the Chief Chaplain for the U.S. Secret Service to provide pastoral support to Agents, Officers, employees and their families. In 2021 deacon Mark was elected Chaplain of American Legion Post 176 in Springfield, and in 2022 he was elected as Chaplain of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 7327 in Springfield.
